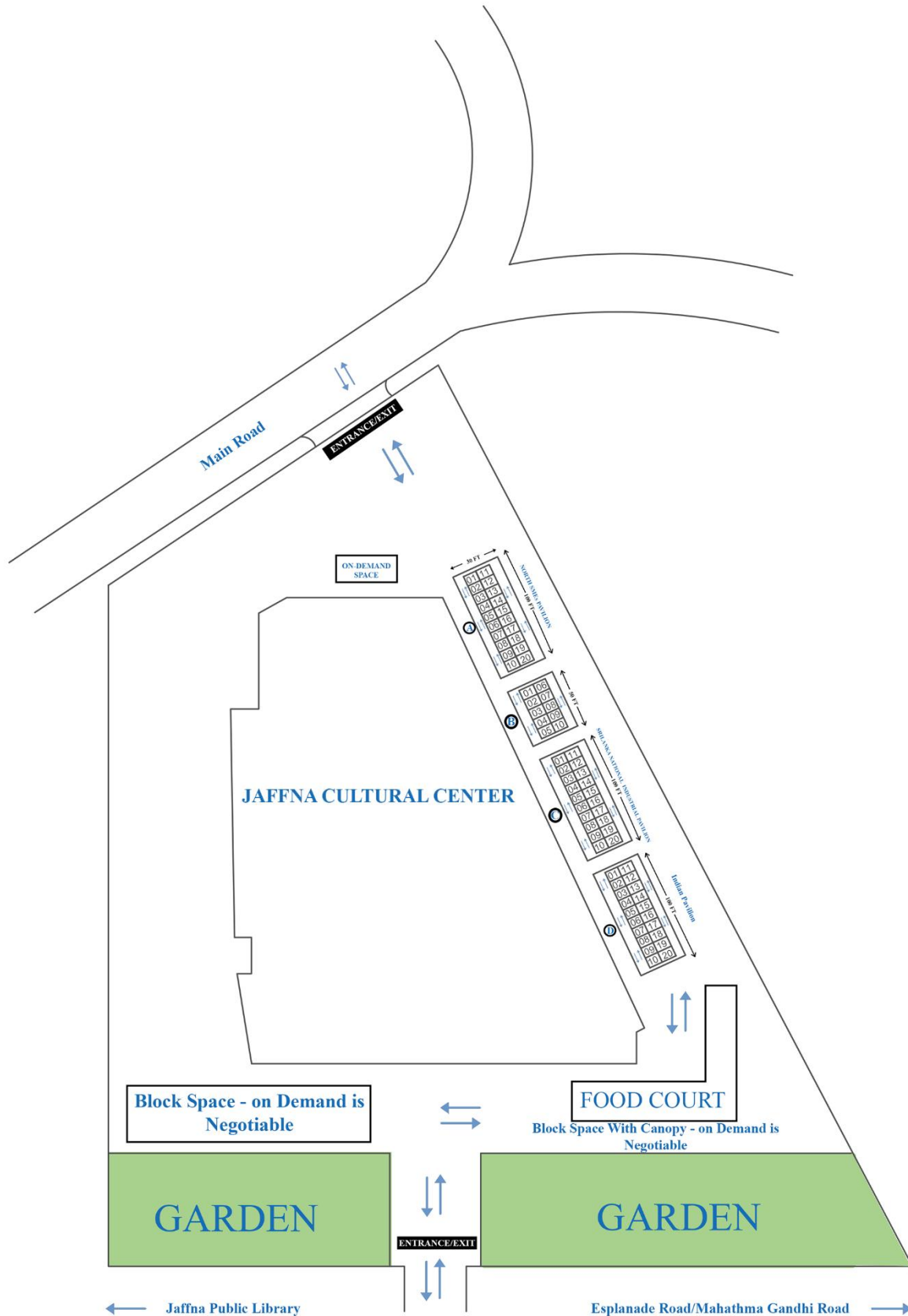

TERMS OF APPLICATION & EXHIBITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

DEFINITIONS

- a. “Organizers” means the Northern Chamber of Industries (NCI), responsible for the regulation and management of all aspects of the Exhibition.
- b. “Exhibition” means Northern International Trade Exhibition – NITE 2026.
- c. “Conditions” means these Terms of Application and Exhibition Rules & Regulations.
- d. “Exhibitor” means the sole proprietorship, partnership, company, institution or organization applying to participate in the Exhibition.
- e. “Exhibition Venue” means Jaffna Thiruvalluvar Cultural Hall, Jaffna.
- f. “Publicity Materials” include brochures, banners, catalogues, samples, promotional materials and advertising items distributed or displayed by exhibitors.

ELIGIBILITY & PARTICIPATION

1. The Organizers reserve absolute discretion in the acceptance or rejection of applications without assigning reasons.
2. Exhibition space is licensed strictly for trade promotion and industrial participation purposes during the Exhibition period.
3. Exhibitors shall use allocated space in a professional and responsible manner acceptable to the Organizers.
4. Space allocations shall not be transferred, shared, sublet or reassigned without written approval from the Organizers.
5. The Organizers reserve the right to clear or alter improperly utilized spaces at the Exhibitor’s expense.

PAYMENT CONDITIONS

1. Application fees are non-refundable except where applications are formally declined by the Organizers.
2. Withdrawal after confirmation shall result in forfeiture of payments made.
3. The Organizers reserve the right to request refundable damage/security deposits where necessary.

SPACE ALLOCATION

1. Space allocation and booth positioning shall be determined solely by the Organizers.
2. Decisions relating to hall layout, traffic management and sector clustering shall be final.

STAND CONSTRUCTION

1. All booth designs must conform to Exhibition safety and venue regulations.
2. No stand or display shall exceed 2.4 meters in height without prior written approval.
3. Raw-space exhibitors must submit stand designs for approval not later than two months before the Exhibition.
4. Unauthorized structural modifications shall not be permitted.
5. Removal and disposal of materials are the responsibility of the Exhibitor.

ELECTRICITY & TECHNICAL SERVICES

1. Electrical installations shall be undertaken only through approved contractors.
2. Power supply shall be 210/230 volt single phase unless otherwise arranged.
3. Multi-plug overloads and unsafe electrical practices are strictly prohibited.

SAFETY & VENUE MANAGEMENT

1. Exhibitors shall comply with all safety regulations applicable within the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.
2. Hazardous, flammable or dangerous materials shall not be permitted without prior approval.
3. Public safety precautions shall be maintained at all times.
4. The Organizers reserve the right to remove objectionable, unsafe or unauthorized materials.

PUBLICITY & PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES

1. Distribution of publicity materials shall be limited to the Exhibitor's allocated space.
2. Unauthorized canvassing or promotions outside allocated areas are prohibited.
3. Audio-visual presentations shall not interfere with neighboring exhibitors.
4. Musical performances, demonstrations and special promotional activities require prior written approval.
5. The Organizers reserve the right to photograph, film and digitally document the Exhibition for promotional and archival purposes.

MOVE-IN & MOVE-OUT

1. Exhibitors shall move in and vacate the Exhibition Venue within the time schedules prescribed by the Organizers.
2. Early dismantling before official closing time shall not be permitted.
3. Materials left behind after the prescribed period may be removed or disposed of at the Exhibitor's expense.

SUSTAINABILITY & RESPONSIBLE PRACTICES

1. Exhibitors are encouraged to minimize single-use plastics and adopt environmentally responsible display practices.
2. Waste disposal shall comply with venue and municipal regulations.
3. Excessive sound, smoke or environmentally harmful activities are prohibited.

CROSS-BORDER TRADE & IMPORT REGULATIONS

1. International exhibitors shall comply with Sri Lankan Customs and temporary import regulations.
2. Machinery and equipment brought into the Exhibition shall comply with national safety and regulatory standards.

TERMINATION & CANCELLATION

1. The Organizers reserve the right to terminate participation in cases of violation of Exhibition regulations.
2. The Organizers reserve the right to alter dates, venue layout, scale or duration of the Exhibition due to circumstances beyond reasonable control.
3. No liability shall arise against the Organizers due to postponement, cancellation or force majeure circumstances.

GOVERNING LAW

These Conditions and Regulations shall be governed by the laws of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, and all participants submit to the jurisdiction of Sri Lankan courts.
